## 2022 S.C.R.A.P. TRACTOR PULL RULES

FENDERS and WHEELIE BARS are Strongly Recommended and are MANDATORY for Any Driver under 18 years old.

Antique Tractor must be original appearing for that tractor. Block, carburetor, injector pump - NO aluminum parts.

Antique classes must have OEM recommended diameter rims and OEM wheels. Tires must be on rim width not exceeding tire manufacturer's recommended width.

- 1. ALL Pull Committee decisions are final, including situations not included in these rules.
- 2. 12-17 year olds allowed to pull with written permission from a parent or guardian.
- 3. Antique 1956 and older must be stock. Semi-Modified 1959 and older.
- 4. Pull Days tractor will be either Antique or Semi-Modified, **NOT BOTH.** All tractors must weigh out and have drawbar height checked.
- 5. Tractor may pull in more than one class, but no more than 2 pulls PER TRACTOR. Tractor can win twice, but with different drivers.
- 6. STOCK engines only! Top 3 tractors per class may be checked for RPM's.
- 7. No manual over-riding of governors (10% over standard engine speed only).
- 8. One restart within 20 feet of pull attempt.
- 9. 3 mph speed limit for Antiques. 5 mph for Semi-Modified.
- 10. Pullers must obey Flagman.
- 11. No jerking must start with tight chain.
- 12. No use of Torque Amplifier, except in Semi-Modified classes.
- 13. Tractors must stay in boundaries.
- Tractors will be stopped if holes are dug.
- 15. Unsafe operators will be disqualified.
- 16. Driver must stay on seat with one hand on the steering wheel.
- 17. Raising the front end over 30" during pull will result in disqualification.
- 18. No fuel leaks. Tractors will be safety inspected.
- 19. 2-wheel drive only. No duals or chains. Steel wheels will pull Exhibition last in the class.
- 20. 12-15 year olds must pull Antique classes. 16 & up can pull Semi-Modified.
- 21. 2750 & 3000 Semi-Modified classes mandatory wheelie bars, 16" draw bar.
- 22. Semi-Modified NO cut, shaved, ground or groomed edges, or radials. 16.9-38 max. tire size.
- 23. Top cut tires 5500 & 6000 Top Cut classes only.
- 24. 18" maximum height of solid hitch or draw bar. 2500 Class 16" maximum height.
- 25. 18" minimum draw bar length from center of axle to hitching point.
- 26. No turbo or blowers in any class.
- 27. Anything falling off tractor during pull will disqualify the driver.
- 28. No external weights allowed in Antique classes. Additional mounted farm related equipment, weights, or brackets will enter you into the Semi-Modified classes.
- 29. Arguing or foul language will disqualify the driver.
- 30. No alcoholic beverages before, during or after the Pull.
- 31. All hitches must be stabilized with struts to not allow for tractor rotation.

  Clevis must be bolted (to not allow for swinging) bolted, not pinned.
- 32. Mandatory Functional Kill Switch must be installed on tractor. NO SWITCH, NO PULLING.
- 33. NO REFUNDS after close of Registration.
