Dear Flea Market Vendor:

I am pleased to announce our **2024 S.C.R.A.P.** event is being organized for another great Labor Day weekend fun filled event. Our feature equipment this year will be *Oliver, Garden Tractors and Maytag Engines*.

The following is base information concerning our **Flea Market** portion of the show and several safety guidelines and rules established in conjunction with our Sandusky County Park District and White Star Park;

Registration: The cost is remaining at **\$2.00 per Foot** of frontage for all registrations received by **June 30, 2024**. Any registration received **July 1 thru the time of the show will be \$3.00 per Foot** of frontage. See the enclosed vendor registration form for additional information.

- **AN OHIO TRANSIENT VENDOR'S LICENSE IS NOT REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SHOW**

Priority will be given to our 20223 vendor participants, with a registration and full payment received by **June 30, 2024**. Any space that does not have a registration by this date will go on the open market and be re-assigned as needed.

Passes & Mirror Hangers: All flea market vendors will receive **2 worker passes** and **1 vehicle mirror hanger** to accommodate getting your vehicle into the grounds and flea market area for the show. ***Please note the change from 2 vehicle hangers to 1. We need to cut down on the amount of vehicles being parked in non-designated areas.** Any other workers will have to purchase a general admission ticket at **\$5.00 per day** or may consider a membership costing **\$20.00**. Purchasing a membership allows **two** persons (1 Voting member and 1 Non-voting member) into the grounds and parking area all weekend, with the additional benefit of receiving S.C.R.A.P. newsletters and updates throughout the year. Please consider this option, as we would appreciate you as an ongoing member of our organization.

Set-up and Check-In: For the show will begin on **Thursday August 29** and we are requesting your consideration to remain on site thru **Monday noon** if at all possible, and until **7:00 P.M.** in the evenings to accommodate late arriving show attendees. If you plan to arrive early Friday morning, please allow enough time to check-in, set-up and remove vehicles by the **8:00 A.M.** start time of the show.

In the days prior to and during the show, the **Flea Market Registration Trailer** will be located at **Row 1 / Space 1** corner front of the flea market area near the red barn. As in the past upon your arrival at the grounds, please come up for check-in and verification of booth location, show information, distribution of passes and vehicle mirror hangers etc.

Parking: Limited parking for vendor cars and small trailers will again be available directly behind the north row of the flea market area **only**. ***There will be no parking in fire lanes or next to the Red Barn this year. For the safety of all parties concerned---No Campsites, Tent set-ups etc. will be allowed in this area.**

As in the past, only flea market vendors only will be allowed to enter and exit the north **(Co. Rd. 65)** entrance gate throughout the show with proper display and passes.

As in past years, an exception to this arrangement will be for a 3 hour period on Sunday afternoon from 4:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. during our tractor line up and parade into Gibsonburg. This has become necessary due to increasing member participation in this key show event and for the safety of all involved. All vendors are requested to utilize the main parking lot entrance and exits unto Co. Rd. 60 during this period, which is easily accessible as always, thru the rear flea market-main road area. Please understand this change for a short time period is necessary to properly accommodate this event.

I have great vendors---that I know will understand---and help us in this effort!

Throughout the show, we will work to accommodate people via golf cart shuttle service with larger, bulky items, etc. purchased at the flea market that need both timely access to the market area, or assistance back to the main parking lot.

Additional Rules and Regulations: *In effect throughout the show are as follows;*

No Guns and no related Ammunition items are allowed for sale in the flea market area.

No Alcohol allowed on the show grounds at any time.

No ATV'S, Bikes or Golf Carts allowed in the flea market area after **8:00 A. M.** during the show.

- ***Friday Only---Golf Carts will be allowed in the Flea Market area!***

****No electrical cords** allowed on the ground that may interfere or be walked on by the general public.

Flea Market vendors are allowed pet dogs at their site. They must be kept leashed and under control.

As a courtesy and consideration to other vendors, **Quiet Time** is designated as **11:00 P.M.** each evening.
